

# 2010 THERAPEUTIC POOL POLICIES

## 1) PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- A City of Altamonte Springs **Physician Consent Form** must be signed by you, your doctor and processed prior to using the pool. We only accept original forms (photo copies, faxes, etc. will not be accepted)
- A computer ID is required at a cost of **\$2.00**.
- Your membership at the Therapeutic Pool is valid for one (1) year from the date of your physician's signature on the City of Altamonte Springs **Physician Consent Form**.
- Non-residents of the City of Altamonte Springs will be charged an annual non-refundable membership fee of **\$150.00**.
- Altamonte Springs city residents must show proof of residency along with a photo ID.
- If you require the use of a personal assistant, the assistant must also have a City of Altamonte Springs **Physician Consent Form** on file. Membership fees may apply.
- Photos will be taken and fees can be collected at the Therapeutic Pool between the following hours:
  - Monday, Tuesday, Thursday & Friday: 9:40am-11:00am, 12:40pm-2:00pm, 3:40pm-6:00pm
  - Wednesday: 9:40am-6:00pm

**NOTE:** Only check, money order, MasterCard and Visa are accepted at the Therapeutic Pool. If you would like to pay in cash you may pay at the Westmonte Recreation Center front office between 9:40am and 5:00pm Monday through Friday.

## 2) CLASS REGISTRATION

- Classes are offered in six (6) week sessions with a **Registration Week** being held the week prior to each session.
- During **Registration Week** there will be no classes. Members are welcome to attend **Open Swim** during regular pool hours.
- During **Registration Week** members must register in person. However, they may register one (1) additional person if room is still available after all people that are present have registered.
- If you can not attend a **Registration Week** please notify The Therapeutic Pool staff to make appropriate arrangements.
- Members may only register for one (1) class at a time. Classes are limited to thirty (30) participants. Members may also have use of the Therapeutic Pool during **Open Swim** times.
- Members who join in the middle of a six (6) week session can register for a class if there is availability in the class of their choice.
- Members who register for an Arthritis Basic or Plus water exercise class must fill out an **Arthritis Foundation®** Participant Release Form.
- Class registrations will not be carried over from one (1) session to the next. Members must register for a class every six (6) weeks.
- Please notify the Therapeutic Staff if you will be absent from a class for more than a two (2) week period.

- If a member is late to class it is at the instructor's discretion if they will be allowed to participate in the class.
- A member may request to attend a class they are not registered for if the instructor gives you verbal permission to enter the class and less than 30 people are present.

### **MORNING AND AFTERNOON REGISTRATION**

- Registration for the Monday / Thursday classes are held on Mondays during the times of the class you wish to sign up for.
- Registration for the Tuesday / Friday classes are held on Tuesdays during the times of the class you wish to sign up for.

### **EVENING REGISTRATION**

- Registration for the 6:00pm and 7:00pm classes will be held on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday between 4:00pm and 8:00pm.

### 3) GENERAL POOL RULES

All persons must shower before entering the pool  
 No food or drink allowed in or around pool area  
 No diving  
 No pets allowed in or around pool area  
 Persons having open sores, blisters, cuts, etc. are advised not to enter the pool  
 No street shoes allowed in pool (water shoes only)  
 Lined swim suits must be worn, no street clothes or cut offs  
 Use ramp for entering and exiting the pool  
 Persons wearing bladder control products must wear rubber pants
