

# Altamonte Racquetball Rules

Revised:1-1-11

---

- This league will be honored by honesty! The league director will not be in attendance.
- Please follow all rules!
- Standard racquetball ball to be used in our league: "Penn Ultra-Blue" Balls are NOT supplied by the league
- 15 minutes after game time is forfeit time! A player with a forfeit (not notifying opponent or league director prior to match) will first be warned and on the second offense they will be dismissed from the league! (League director has final say!)
- If you need to reschedule a match it is your responsibility to call the court reservation number, (407-571-8740) **cancel original reservation and schedule a new one.** The person responsible for rescheduling must pay the court fees (\$2 per person/per hour). A **rescheduled match must be played within one week of original match date!** If the match is not re-scheduled within that week, the person cancelling the match will receive a loss. (Exception: if you call and explain to the league director why you need more than 1 week to re-schedule and he/she makes an exception) A rescheduled match can also be played in advanced. Notify League Director of score!
- Each Player will play One (1) match per night.
  - A match is won by the first side to win two (2) games. The first two (2) games of a match are played to 15, win by one (1). If each side wins one game, a tiebreaker game is played to 11, win by two (2).
  - Flip a coin to decide who serves 1<sup>st</sup> in the tie-breaker game
- You will have **ONE (1)** hour of reserved court time to finish your racquetball match. If you go over this time and someone has the court reserved after you, you must find a different court or time to finish your match.
- **Winner must call in or email final score of their match by 12:00pm Friday of each week.**

- Please note that standings should be updated by 5:00pm every Friday!
- A five (5) minute break may be taken between games.
- Each player gets **ONE (1)** 30 second timeout per game!
- If a player needs to take an additional timeout a point will be subtracted from his score for each additional timeout. (Exception: injuries that require medical attention)
- **Good sportsmanship is expected at all times!**
- Foul Language will not be tolerated!
- We reserve the right to suspend or dismiss any player for any unsportsmanlike conduct.
- League Directors word is final!
- Playoff standings are determined by your win lose record and by how many points you allow your opponent to score against you

## Hinders

Hinders are stoppages of play, and result in the replay of the point. It is your responsibility to give your opponent enough room to hit the shot the way they want to hit. You must give them a straight

shot to the front wall as well as the angle, which would result in a crosscourt shot to the opposite back corner. Typical hinders are:

- A ball striking any part of the court, which results in an erratic rebound (fan vents, door knob, lights, etc.)
- Accidentally hitting opponent with the ball as it is heading toward the front wall
- Unintentionally contacting opponent while attempting to make a play on the ball
- Screening opponent's view of the ball or having the ball pass between one's legs.
